There are three different types of downloads: General Deployment (GD)

General Deployment releases are considered to be *stable* and are supposed to be quite *matur e*

(based on download stats).

Use these Versions for a production Environment

General Availability (GA)

General Availability Versions are considered to be *stable* but are quite new and *have not yet* been deployed widely enough (based on download stats)

All bug fixes and enhancements will be *first released as a general availability* release and moved to a General Deployment release once a *particular version is stable enough.*note that a GD release may still contain bugs, which have been fixed in a GA release!

Snapshots

If you want to play with the *latest and the greatest features* then download one of a *daily snapshot* releases which are made once a week From time to time ... one of these snapshots will be released as a GA Release.

Do note that these versions are not production ready. (or at least have not been tested for that purpose)
